Customer Bed Bug Prep Sheet

Triangle Pest Control is known as the top Bed Bug Exterminator in the Raleigh Durham area. We have experience in dealing with Bed Bug problems in both residential and commercial settings.

These insects are very difficult to eradicate and we have developed a special checklist for our customers to complete during the extermination process. When this checklist is followed we have discovered that not only are our treatments faster and more effective, but also the treatments up costing our customers less time and money.

The preparations that we request are minimal, but they are crucial to the success of the program.

We ask that you please review this worksheet and **complete it in the order indicated** for your treatment. Please keep in mind that **our success will be a team effort**. This means that you will need to help us help you by completing this checklist.

Items to complete prior to our arrival

- DO** clear tops and empty cabinets of nightstands, end tables, dressers, etc. We will be turning furniture upside down to treat the bottoms.
- DO** pull items at least 5" away from baseboards so that we will be able to treat all of the baseboards.
- DO** secure any private, valuable, or important items. We will be going through closets, opening, drawers, etc.
- DO** remove any pets and seal any fish tanks (turn off filter and air supply and wrap tank with plastic wrap)
- DO** be prepared to vacate the dwelling during service and for about 3-4 hours following service to allow time for chemicals to dry.

Things not to do before our arrival

- DO NOT** place any items on top of the beds
- DO NOT** throw away any furniture or beds.
- DO NOT** strip linens from beds.
- DO NOT** store items on or under beds.

After our treatment is complete

- DO NOT** remove the mattress encasements from any bed for any reason
- DO NOT** clean any of the treated areas for at least two weeks (base boards, etc...)

- DO** bag, launder and dry your garments (hot cycle) as directed by your technician
- DO** vacuum in and around your baseboards, bedding and other treatment areas
- DO** allow the treatment to become effective. In some cases you may notice another bite after our treatment. This could be due to a number of reasons; however, you should not be getting bit two weeks after our treatment
- DO** expect that we will need to complete 2-3 follow up treatments after your initial treatment. In some cases we can eradicate your property in one visit; however, you should prepare for the worst
